Mr. DODD submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Urging all sides to the current political crisis in Ukraine to act responsibly and use dialogue to resolve the crisis and ensure a free and transparent democratic system in Ukraine based on the rule of law.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring), That Congress—*

3 (1) acknowledges and welcomes the strong rela-
4 tionship formed between the United States and
5 Ukraine since the restoration of Ukraine's independ-
6 ence in 1991;

1 (2) urges all sides to the current political crisis
2 in Ukraine to act responsibly and use dialogue to re-
3 solve the crisis;

4 (3) urges all sides to adhere to the rule of law
5 and resolve disputes in a peaceful manner consistent
6 with Ukraine’s democratic values and national inter-
7 est, in keeping with its commitments as a member
8 of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in
9 Europe (OSCE);

10 (4) expresses strong and continuing support for
11 the efforts of the Ukrainian people to establish a full
12 democracy, the rule of law, and respect for human
13 rights;

14 (5) pledges its continued assistance to the
15 strengthening of a free and transparent democratic
16 system in Ukraine based on the rule of law and the
17 continued development of a free market economy in
18 Ukraine; and

19 (6) reaffirms its commitment to Ukraine’s inde-
20 pendence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, and
21 assumption of Ukraine’s rightful place as a full
22 member of the international community of democ-
23 racies.
