RESOLUTION

Expressing the condolences of the Senate on the tragic events
at Virginia Tech University.

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) offers its heartfelt condolences to the vic-
3 tims and their families, and to students, faculty, ad-
4 ministration and staff and their families who have
5 been deeply affected by the tragic events that oc-
6 curred today at Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, Vir-
7 ginia;

8 (2) expresses its hope that today's losses will
9 lead to a shared national commitment to take steps
10 that will help our communities prevent such trage-
11 dies from occurring in the future; and

12 (3) recognizes that Virginia Tech has served as
13 an exemplary institution of teaching, learning, and
14 research for well over a century; and that the Uni-
15 versity's historic and proud traditions will carry on.
