A BILL

To redesignate a Federal building in Albuquerque, New Mexico, as the “Raymond G. Murphy Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building known and designated as the
5 “Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center” located
6 at 1501 San Pedro Drive, SE, in Albuquerque, New Mex-
7 ico, shall be known and redesignated as the “Raymond
8 G. Murphy Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Cen-
9 ter”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Raymond G. Murphy Department of
6 Veterans Affairs Medical Center”.
