To designate the United States Courthouse to be constructed in Jackson, Mississippi, as the “R. Jess Brown United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States Courthouse to be constructed at  
5 the site bounded on the north by Court Street, on the west  
6 by West Street, on the south by South Street, and on the

1 east by President Street in Jackson, Mississippi, shall be  
2 known and designated as the “R. Jess Brown United  
3 States Courthouse”.

4 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

5 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
6 paper, or other record of the United States to the court-  
7 house referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a ref-  
8 erence to the “R. Jess Brown United States Courthouse”.
