AN ACT

To designate the United States Courthouse to be constructed in Jackson, Mississippi, as the “R. Jess Brown United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 The United States Courthouse to be constructed at
3 the site bounded on the north by Court Street, on the west
4 by West Street, on the south by South Street, and on the
5 east by President Street in Jackson, Mississippi, shall be
6 known and designated as the “R. Jess Brown United
7 States Courthouse”.

8 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

9 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
10 paper, or other record of the United States to the court-
11 house referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a ref-
12 erence to the “R. Jess Brown United States Courthouse”.
