## AN ACT

To amend Public Law 106–348 to extend the authorization for establishing a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR ESTABLISHING**  
2 **DISABLED VETERANS MEMORIAL.**

3 Public Law 106–348 is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (b)—

5 (A) by striking “The establishment” and  
6 inserting “Except as provided in subsection (e),  
7 the establishment”; and

8 (B) by striking “the Commemorative  
9 Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.)” and in-  
10 serting “chapter 89 of title 40, United States  
11 Code”;

12 (2) in subsection (d)—

13 (A) by striking “section 8(b) of the Com-  
14 memorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b))”  
15 and inserting “section 8906 of title 40, United  
16 States Code”;

17 (B) by striking “or upon expiration of the  
18 authority for the memorial under section 10(b)  
19 of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)),”; and

20 (C) by striking “section 8(b)(1) of such  
21 Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)(1))” and inserting  
22 “8906(b)(2) or (3) of such title”; and

23 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
24 section:

25 “(e) **TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.**—Notwith-  
26 standing section 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code,

1 the authority to establish a memorial under this section  
2 shall expire on October 24, 2015.”.
