Ms. LANDRIEU introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Jiao Ying Li.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1101 et seq.), Jiao Ying Li shall be considered to have  
7 been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent  
8 residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon  
9 payment of the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent resident status to  
12 Jiao Ying Li, as provided in section 1, the Secretary of

1 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1 dur-  
2 ing the current or next following fiscal year the total num-  
3 ber of immigrant visas available to natives of the country  
4 of the birth of Jiao Ying Li under section 202(a)(2) of  
5 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1152(a)(2)).
