**A BILL**

To amend chapter 89 of title 5, United States Code, to make individuals employed by the Roosevelt Campobello International Park Commission eligible to obtain Federal health insurance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HEALTH INSURANCE.**

4 Section 8901(1) of title 5, United States Code, is  
5 amended—

1           (1) in subparagraph (H), by striking “and” at  
2 the end;

3           (2) in subparagraph (I), by inserting “and”  
4 after the semicolon; and

5           (3) by inserting before the matter following  
6 subparagraph (I) the following:

7                   “(J) an individual who is employed by the  
8 Roosevelt Campobello International Park Com-  
9 mission and is a citizen of the United States,”.
