A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 896 Pittsburgh Street in Springdale, Pennsylvania, as the “Rachel Carson Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RACHEL CARSON POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 896 Pittsburgh Street in Spring-
6 dale, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the
7 “Rachel Carson Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Rachel Carson Post
5 Office Building”.
