# S. 1475

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Bay Area Regional Water Recycling Program, and for other purposes.

Mrs. FEINSTEIN (for herself and Mrs. BOXER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

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## A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Bay Area Regional Water Recycling Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bay Area Regional  
5 Water Recycling Program Authorization Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
8 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–

1 575, title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by  
2 adding at the end the following:

3 **“SEC. 16xx. MOUNTAIN VIEW, MOFFETT AREA RECLAIMED**  
4 **WATER PIPELINE PROJECT.**

5 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
6 tion with the City of Palo Alto, California, and the City  
7 of Mountain View, California, is authorized to participate  
8 in the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
9 distribution systems.

10 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
11 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
12 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

13 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
14 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
15 authorized by this section.

16 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
17 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
18 \$5,000,000.

19 **“SEC. 16xx. PITTSBURG RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

20 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
21 tion with the City of Pittsburg, California, and the Delta  
22 Diablo Sanitation District, is authorized to participate in  
23 the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
24 system facilities.

1       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
2 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
3 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

4       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
5 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
6 authorized by this section.

7       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
8 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
9 \$1,400,000.

10 **“SEC. 16xx. ANTIOCH RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

11       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
12 tion with the City of Antioch, California, and the Delta  
13 Diablo Sanitation District, is authorized to participate in  
14 the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
15 system facilities.

16       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
17 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
18 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

19       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
20 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
21 authorized by this section.

22       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
23 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
24 \$2,250,000.

1 **“SEC. 16xx. NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT RECY-**  
2 **CLED WATER PROJECT.**

3 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
4 tion with the North Coast County Water District, is au-  
5 thorized to participate in the design, planning, and con-  
6 struction of recycled water system facilities.

7 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
8 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
9 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

10 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
11 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
12 authorized by this section.

13 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
14 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
15 \$2,500,000.

16 **“SEC. 16xx. REDWOOD CITY RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

17 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
18 tion with the City of Redwood City, California, is author-  
19 ized to participate in the design, planning, and construc-  
20 tion of recycled water system facilities.

21 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
22 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
23 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

24 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
25 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
26 authorized by this section.

3 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
4 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
5 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

6 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
7 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
8 authorized by this section.

9 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
10 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
11 \$8,250,000.”.

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The table of items  
13 in section 2 of Public Law 102–575 is amended by insert-  
14 ing after the item relating to section 16xx the following:

“Sec. 16xx. Mountain View, Moffett Area Reclaimed Water Pipeline Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. Pittsburg Recycled Water Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. Antioch Recycled Water Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. North Coast County Water District Recycled Water Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. Redwood City Recycled Water Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. South Santa Clara County Recycled Water Project.  
“Sec. 16xx. South Bay Advanced Recycled Water Treatment Facility.”.

15 **SEC. 3. SAN JOSE AREA WATER RECLAMATION AND REUSE**  
16 **PROJECT.**

17 It is the intent of Congress that a comprehensive  
18 water recycling program for the San Francisco Bay Area  
19 include the San Jose Area water reclamation and reuse  
20 program authorized by section 1607 of the Reclamation

- 1 Projects Authorization and Adjustment Act of 1992 (43
- 2 U.S.C 390h-5).
