## AN ACT

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater  
Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Bay Area Re-  
gional Water Recycling Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Bay Area Regional  
3 Water Recycling Program Authorization Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
6 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–  
7 575, title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by  
8 adding at the end the following:

9 **“SEC. 16xx. MOUNTAIN VIEW, MOFFETT AREA RECLAIMED**  
10 **WATER PIPELINE PROJECT.**

11 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
12 tion with the City of Palo Alto, California, and the City  
13 of Mountain View, California, is authorized to participate  
14 in the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
15 distribution systems.

16 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
17 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
18 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

19 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
20 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
21 authorized by this section.

22 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
23 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
24 \$5,000,000.

1 **“SEC. 16xx. PITTSBURG RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

2       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
3 tion with the City of Pittsburg, California, and the Delta  
4 Diablo Sanitation District, is authorized to participate in  
5 the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
6 system facilities.

7       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
8 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
9 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

10       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
11 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
12 authorized by this section.

13       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
14 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
15 \$1,750,000.

16 **“SEC. 16xx. ANTIOCH RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

17       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
18 tion with the City of Antioch, California, and the Delta  
19 Diablo Sanitation District, is authorized to participate in  
20 the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
21 system facilities.

22       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
23 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
24 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

12 **“SEC. 16xx. SOUTH SANTA CLARA COUNTY RECYCLED**  
13 **WATER PROJECT.**

14 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
15 tion with the South County Regional Wastewater Author-  
16 ity and the Santa Clara Valley Water District, is author-  
17 ized to participate in the design, planning, and construc-  
18 tion of recycled water system distribution facilities.

19 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
20 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
21 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

22 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
23 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
24 authorized by this section.

1 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
 2 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
 3 \$7,000,000.

4 **“SEC. 16xx. SOUTH BAY ADVANCED RECYCLED WATER**  
 5 **TREATMENT FACILITY.**

6 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
 7 tion with the City of San Jose, California, and the Santa  
 8 Clara Valley Water District, is authorized to participate  
 9 in the design, planning, and construction of recycled water  
 10 treatment facilities.

11 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
 12 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
 13 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

14 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
 15 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
 16 authorized by this section.

17 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
 18 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
 19 \$8,250,000.”.

20 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The table of sec-  
 21 tions for Public Law 102–575 is amended by inserting  
 22 after the last item relating to title XVI the following:

- “Sec. 16xx. Mountain View, Moffett Area Reclaimed Water Pipeline Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. Pittsburg Recycled Water Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. Antioch Recycled Water Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. North Coast County Water District Recycled Water Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. Redwood City Recycled Water Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. South Santa Clara County Recycled Water Project.
- “Sec. 16xx. South Bay Advanced Recycled Water Treatment Facility.”.

1 **SEC. 3. SAN JOSE AREA WATER RECLAMATION AND REUSE**  
2 **PROJECT.**

3 It is the intent of Congress that a comprehensive  
4 water recycling program for the San Francisco Bay Area  
5 include the San Jose Area water reclamation and reuse  
6 program authorized by section 1607 of the Reclamation  
7 Projects Authorization and Adjustment Act of 1992 (43  
8 U.S.C. 390h-5).
