AN ACT

To amend title 18, United States Code, to make technical corrections to the new border tunnels and passages offense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. OFFENSE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 27 of title 18, United
3 States Code, is amended by redesignating section 554
4 added by section 551(a) of the Department of Homeland
5 Security Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public Law 109–295;
6 120 Stat. 1389) (relating to border tunnels and passages)
7 as section 555.

8 (b) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections for
9 chapter 27 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
10 by striking the item relating to section 554, “Border tun-
11 nels and passages”, and inserting the following:

“555. Border tunnels and passages.”.

12 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL FORFEITURE.**

13 Section 982(a)(6) of title 18, United States Code, is
14 amended by striking “554” and inserting “555”.

15 **SEC. 3. DIRECTIVE TO THE UNITED STATES SENTENCING**
16 **COMMISSION.**

17 Section 551(d) of the Department of Homeland Secu-
18 rity Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public Law 109–295; 120
19 Stat. 1390) is amended in paragraphs (1) and (2)(A) by
20 striking “554” and inserting “555”.
