## A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to exempt certain local restrictions from review under the airport noise and access restriction review program.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AIRPORT NOISE AND ACCESS RESTRICTION RE-**  
4       **VIEW PROGRAM.**

5       Section 47524(d) of title 49, United States Code, is  
6       amended—

7               (1) by striking “or” at the end of paragraph  
8       (5)(B);

9               (2) by striking the period at the end of para-  
10       graph (6) and inserting “; or”; and

1           (3) by adding at the end the following:

2           “(7) a local restriction limiting the hours of op-  
3           eration of a publicly-owned airport maintained by  
4           the owner of the airport, if the owner had previously  
5           maintained a local restriction limiting the hours of  
6           operation of the airport that was disallowed by a  
7           court before 1985, and the owner has—

8                   “(A) without interruption since 1985,  
9                   maintained a policy of encouraging voluntary  
10                  limitation of the hours of operation of the air-  
11                  port;

12                   “(B) without interruption since 1985, im-  
13                  posed restrictions limiting the capacity of the  
14                  airport terminal; and

15                   “(C) developed and implemented an envi-  
16                  ronmental management system that is certified  
17                  as conforming to the International Standards  
18                  Organization 14001 Environmental Manage-  
19                  ment System Standard.”.
