## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to prohibit the collection of copayments for all hospice care furnished by the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON COLLECTION OF COPAY-**  
4 **MENTS FOR ALL HOSPICE CARE FURNISHED**  
5 **BY DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

6 Section 1710B(c)(2) of title 38, United States Code  
7 is amended by striking subparagraph (B) and inserting  
8 after subparagraph (A) the following new subparagraph  
9 (B):

1           “(B) to a veteran being furnished inpatient or  
2           outpatient hospice care by the Department; or”.
