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**A BILL**

To amend the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to provide an alternate sulfur dioxide removal measurement for certain coal gasification project goals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CRITERIA FOR CLEAN COAL**  
2 **POWER INITIATIVE.**

3 Section 402(b)(1)(B)(ii) of the Energy Policy Act of  
4 2005 (42 U.S.C. 15962(b)(1)(B)(ii)) is amended by strik-  
5 ing subclause (I) and inserting the following:

6 “(I)(aa) to remove at least 99  
7 percent of sulfur dioxide; or

8 “(bb) to emit not more than 0.04  
9 pound SO<sub>2</sub> per million Btu, based on  
10 a 30-day average;”.



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
