2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. JOHN “MARTY” THIELS SOUTHPARK STATION.**

2 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
3 Postal Service known as the Southpark Station in Alexan-  
4 dria, Louisiana, shall be known and designated as the  
5 “John ‘Marty’ Thiels Southpark Station”.

6 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
7 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
8 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
9 be deemed to be a reference to the “John ‘Marty’ Thiels  
10 Southpark Station”.
