**A BILL**

To reform mutual aid agreements for the National Capital Region.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REFORM OF MUTUAL AID AGREEMENTS FOR**  
2 **THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION.**

3 Section 7302 of the Intelligence Reform and Ter-  
4 rorism Prevention Act of 2004 (42 U.S.C. 5196 note) is  
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)—

7 (A) in paragraph (4), by striking “, includ-  
8 ing its agents or authorized volunteers,”; and

9 (B) in paragraph (5), by striking “or  
10 town” and all that follows and inserting “town,  
11 or other governmental agency, governmental au-  
12 thority, or governmental institution with the  
13 power to sue or be sued in its own name, within  
14 the National Capital Region.”;

15 (2) in subsection (b)(1), in the matter pre-  
16 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “, the Wash-  
17 ington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, the  
18 Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority, and  
19 any other governmental agency or authority”; and

20 (3) in subsection (d), by striking “or employ-  
21 ees” each place that term appears and inserting “,  
22 employees, or agents”.
