## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate adjourns on any day  
3 from Tuesday, December 18, 2007, through Monday, De-  
4 cember 31, 2007, on a motion offered pursuant to this  
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-  
6 ignee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until the time of any  
7 reassembly pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolu-  
8 tion; and that when the House adjourns on any legislative  
9 day from Tuesday, December 18, 2007, through Saturday,  
10 December 22, 2007, on a motion offered pursuant to this  
11 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-  
12 ignee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until the time of any  
13 reassembly pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolu-  
14 tion.

15       SEC. 2. When the Senate recesses or adjourns on  
16 Thursday, January 3, 2008, on a motion offered pursuant  
17 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
18 designee, it shall stand recessed or adjourned until noon  
19 on Tuesday, January 22, 2008, or such other time on that

1 day as may be specified in the motion to recess or adjourn,  
2 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section  
3 3 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and  
4 when the House adjourns on the legislative day of Thurs-  
5 day, January 3, 2008, on a motion offered pursuant to  
6 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
7 designee, it shall stand recessed or adjourned until noon  
8 on Tuesday, January 15, 2008, or until the time of any  
9 reassembly pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolu-  
10 tion, whichever occurs first.

11       SEC. 3. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the  
12 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting  
13 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
14 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify  
15 Members of the Senate and the House, respectively, to re-  
16 assemble at such a place and time as they may designate  
17 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
