AN ACT

To authorize appropriations for the San Gabriel Basin
Restoration Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SAN GABRIEL BASIN RESTORATION FUND.**

2 Section 110 of division B of the Miscellaneous Appro-
3 priations Act, 2001 (114 Stat. 2763A–222), as enacted
4 into law by section 1(a)(4) of the Consolidated Appropria-
5 tions Act, 2001 (Public Law 106–554, as amended by
6 Public Law 107–66), is further amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)(3)(B), by inserting after
8 clause (iii) the following:

9 “(iv) NON-FEDERAL MATCH.—After
10 \$85,000,000 has cumulatively been appro-
11 priated under subsection (d)(1), the re-
12 mainder of Federal funds appropriated
13 under subsection (d) shall be subject to the
14 following matching requirement:

15 “(I) SAN GABRIEL BASIN WATER
16 QUALITY AUTHORITY.—The San Ga-
17 briel Basin Water Quality Authority
18 shall be responsible for providing a 35
19 percent non-Federal match for Fed-
20 eral funds made available to the Au-
21 thority under this Act.

22 “(II) CENTRAL BASIN MUNICIPAL
23 WATER DISTRICT.—The Central Basin
24 Municipal Water District shall be re-
25 sponsible for providing a 35 percent
26 non-Federal match for Federal funds

1 made available to the District under
2 this Act.”;

3 (2) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
4 following:

5 “(4) INTEREST ON FUNDS IN RESTORATION
6 FUND.—No amounts appropriated above the cumu-
7 lative amount of \$85,000,000 to the Restoration
8 Fund under subsection (d)(1) shall be invested by
9 the Secretary of the Treasury in interest-bearing se-
10 curities of the United States.”; and

11 (3) by amending subsection (d) to read as fol-
12 lows:

13 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

14 “(1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be
15 appropriated to the Restoration Fund established
16 under subsection (a) \$146,200,000. Such funds shall
17 remain available until expended.

18 “(2) SET-ASIDE.—Of the amounts appropriated
19 under paragraph (1), no more than \$21,200,000

1 shall be made available to carry out the Central
2 Basin Water Quality Project.”.
