## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 100 West Percy Street in Indianola, Mississippi, as the “Minnie Cox Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MINNIE COX POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 100 West Percy Street in  
6 Indianola, Mississippi, shall be known and designated as  
7 the “Minnie Cox Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Minnie Cox Post Of-  
3 fice Building”.
