

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2730 – HB 3443

January 24, 2008

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes the beginning and ending dates for the March 2008 sales tax holiday so that the holiday begins at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, March 14, 2008, and ends at 11:59 p.m. on Sunday March 16, 2008, instead of beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, March 21, 2008, and ending at 11:59 p.m. on March 23, 2008.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:


Increase State Expenditures - \$2,000/One-Time

Assumptions:

- Revenue collections for April 2008 (reflecting business activity conducted in March 2008) to state and local governments are not expected to change significantly.
- There would be a one-time increase to state expenditures for the Department of Revenue to make computer and software changes estimated to be \$2,000.
