SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2053 by Representative Otto

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2053 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2053 would authorize the governing body of any city, county, or school district to opt out of state licensure of child care facilities. Any local government or school district choosing to opt out of state regulations would be required to adopt its own child care licensure requirements.

The Department of Health and Environment is unable to estimate the fiscal effect of this bill because it is not known how many governing bodies would opt out of state regulation.
