RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 263) to establish the Joint Select Committee on Earmark Reform, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall, without intervention of any
3 point of order, consider in the House the concurrent reso-
4 lution (H. Con. Res. 263) to establish the Joint Select
5 Committee on Earmark Reform, and for other purposes.
6 The concurrent resolution shall be considered as read. The
7 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
8 concurrent resolution to final adoption without intervening
9 motion or demand for division of the question except: (1)

1 one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the
2 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
3 on Rules; and (2) one motion to recommit to be offered
4 by the majority leader or his designee which may not con-
5 tain instructions.
