QUALCOMM Million Dollar Challenge Commemorative Week.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 66, Wyland. QUALCOMM Million Dollar Challenge  
Commemorative Week.

This measure would declare the week of October 20 to October  
28, 2007, to be QUALCOMM Million Dollar Challenge  
Commemorative Week.

WHEREAS, The Challenged Athletes Foundation (CAF) was  
established in 1997 to provide opportunities and support for people  
with physical disabilities so that they can pursue active lifestyles  
through physical fitness and competitive athletics; and

WHEREAS, CAF has raised more than \$11 million dollars  
thereby allowing it to satisfy more than 2,500 funding requests  
from challenged athletes in all 50 states and 10 countries; and

WHEREAS, The QUALCOMM Million Dollar Challenge is a  
seven-day, 600-mile bicycle ride down the California coastline  
from San Francisco to San Diego, beginning on Saturday, October  
20, 2007, with an arrival in San Diego on Friday, October 26,  
2007, and including an optional 56-mile final stage on Sunday,  
October 28, 2007; and

WHEREAS, The money raised from the QUALCOMM Million  
Dollar Challenge will help seed a capital campaign for the  
construction of a CAF headquarters facility, unless otherwise  
directed by the donor, in which case the donation will be applied  
towards payment for handcycles, racing chairs, sports chairs, and  
sports prosthetics for challenged athletes, as well as helping to  
subsidize the competition expenses and training expenses of  
challenged athletes; now, therefore, be it

*Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, the Assembly  
thereof concurring,* That the week of October 20 to October 28,  
2007, is hereby declared to be QUALCOMM Million Dollar  
Challenge Commemorative Week; and be it further
