

**CORRECTED FISCAL MEMORANDUM
SB 2614 – HB 2729**

February 26, 2008

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (014165): Establishes the provider of hospice services, instead of the hospice, as the entity that must be available to assess, plan, monitor, direct and evaluate the resident's palliative care.

CORRECTED FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Other Fiscal Impact – The Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities will hold an additional meeting in FY09 at a total cost of \$6,000 for travel reimbursements, per diem, a court reporter and a transcript. These one-time expenditures can be funded from existing resources of the Board without the collection of additional revenue.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

On February 19, 2008, we issued a fiscal memorandum for this bill as amended with a fiscal impact of *unchanged from the original fiscal note*. Based on additional information received from the Department of Health, the fiscal impact of this bill as amended is estimated as follows:

Unchanged from the corrected fiscal note.


Assumption applied to amendment:

- The amendatory language will not change the one-time increase in expenditures of \$6,000 for the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities to hold an additional meeting. These one-time expenditures can be funded from existing resources of the Board without the collection of additional revenue.
