SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2786 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2786 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2786 would allow the use of city issued license plates or a reproduction of city issued license plates for antique vehicles. The bill would require the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Revenue to register these license plates.

The Department of Revenue states it has no information concerning city issued license plates and it would need to research which cities within Kansas issued license plates, in what year or years the license plates were issued, and what the license plates looked like. The Department estimates that there will be less than 500 antique vehicles of a vintage that would qualify under the provisions of HB 2786. The Department also estimates that the passage of HB 2786 would require ten days of contract programming time at a cost of \$6,400 to modify the
