

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3482 - HB 3617

March 1, 2008

SUMMARY OF BILL: Redefines “home medical equipment services” to include equipment that is delivered to a predetermined location for the consumer or consumer’s representative to pick up.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:


Other Fiscal Impact - The Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities will hold an additional meeting in FY09 at a total cost of \$6,000 for travel reimbursements, per diems, and a court reporter. These one-time expenditures can be funded from existing resources of the Board without the collection of additional revenue.

Assumptions:

- The Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities will hold an additional meeting to amend current regulations governing home medical equipment services.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 4-3-1011 and 63-1-137, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period.
