
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2935 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2935 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Existing law concerning the dissolution of cemetery corporations requires that the Attorney General dissolve the corporation of a cemetery that is abandoned and the title to the property owned by the corporation returns to the municipality in which the cemetery is located. HB 2935 would make any existing liens against such property invalid after January 1, 2003. HB 2935 would take effect upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

Passage of HB 2935 would have no fiscal effect on the state budget. By invalidating liens on property transferred to cities, the bill could save money for those affected local governments.
