1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.531, subdivision 1, is amended to

2.1 Beginning in fiscal year 2002, two percent of the state total adult basic education
2.2 aid must be set aside for adult basic education supplemental service grants under section
2.3 124D.522.

2.4 (b) The state total adult basic education aid, excluding basic population aid, equals
2.5 the difference between the amount computed in paragraph (a), and the state total basic
2.6 population aid under subdivision 2.
