1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education finance; increasing the funding for the community education  
1.3 youth service program; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.20,  
1.4 subdivisions 4, 4a.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.20, subdivision 4, is amended to  
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 4. **Youth service revenue.** Youth service program revenue is available to  
1.9 a district that has implemented a youth development plan and a youth service program.  
1.10 Youth service revenue equals ~~\$1~~ \$1.25 times the greater of ~~1,335~~ 2,000 or the population  
1.11 of the district.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2008.

1.13 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.20, subdivision 4a, is amended to read:

1.14 Subd. 4a. **Youth after-school enrichment revenue.** ~~In fiscal year 2003 and~~  
1.15 ~~thereafter,~~ Youth after-school enrichment revenue for a district operating a youth  
1.16 after-school enrichment program under section 124D.19, subdivision 12, equals:

1.17 (1) ~~\$1.85~~ \$2.25 times the greater of ~~1,335~~ 2,000 or the population of the district, as  
1.18 defined in section 275.14, not to exceed 10,000; and

1.19 (2) ~~\$0.43~~ \$1 times the population of the district, as defined in section 275.14, in  
1.20 excess of 10,000. Youth after-school enrichment revenue must be reserved for youth  
1.21 after-school enrichment programs.

1.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2008.
