

1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to children's environmental health; establishing requirements for paint
1.3 retailers; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325E.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[325E.386] REQUIREMENTS FOR PAINT RETAILERS.**

1.6 A person selling paint to the public in quantities of one gallon or more must do
1.7 the following:

1.8 (1) make available copies of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's
1.9 "Protecting Your Family From Lead" pamphlet to all paint customers;

1.10 (2) place a poster visible in the paint department that informs customers of the
1.11 right to receive a copy of the pamphlet; and

1.12 (3) offer for sale a lead dust test kit that is capable of determining the presence of
1.13 lead-based paint hazards.
