The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Transportation Finance Division

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to transportation; permitting deputy registrar office to be moved in city
1.3 of New Prague.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **DEPUTY REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES OFFICE MOVE.**

1.6 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 168.33, and rules adopted by the
1.7 commissioner of public safety limiting sites for the office of deputy registrar based on
1.8 (1) moving the deputy registrar office to a new location within the same county, (2) the
1.9 distance to an existing deputy registrar office, or (3) the annual volume of transactions
1.10 processed by any deputy registrar, the commissioner of public safety shall by May 31,
1.11 2008, grant a variance to the State Bank of New Prague to move its office of deputy
1.12 registrar within the limits of the city of New Prague from Scott County to Le Sueur
1.13 County, with full authority to function as a registration and motor vehicle tax collection
1.14 and driver's license bureau. All other provisions regarding the operation of a deputy
1.15 registrar of motor vehicles and driver's license agent under Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.16 168.33 and 171.061, and Minnesota Rules, chapter 7406, apply to the office. The office
1.17 move must take place by December 31, 2008.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
