The bill was read for the first time and Interim introduction, referred to Finance

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to capital investment; authorizing spending to acquire and better public  
1.3 land and buildings and other improvements of a capital nature; authorizing the  
1.4 issuance of state bonds; appropriating money for the renovation of Mott Hall on  
1.5 the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf campus.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **MINNESOTA STATE ACADEMIES; MOTT HALL RENOVATION.**

1.8 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$3,301,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds  
1.9 fund to the commissioner of administration to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and  
1.10 equip the renovation of Mott Hall on the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf campus.

1.11 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from  
1.12 the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the  
1.13 state in an amount up to \$3,301,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect  
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota  
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
