1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to highway safety; requiring all school districts to maintain a "How's
1.3 My Driving?" program; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.4 chapter 169.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[169.4491] SCHOOL BUSES; SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION**
1.7 **SERVICE VEHICLES; DRIVER INCIDENT REPORTING PROGRAM.**

1.8 A school district must provide a program that allows persons who observe instances
1.9 of unsafe driving of a school bus operated by or under contract to the district to report
1.10 those instances to a telephone hotline maintained by the district. The program must
1.11 include the prominent placement of a sticker on the rear of each school bus containing the
1.12 phrase "How's My Driving?" and the telephone hotline number maintained by the district.
