

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; adding legislators who represent the capitol area
1.3 as nonvoting members of the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board;
1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 15B.03, subdivision 1.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 15B.03, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Membership.** (a) The Capitol Area Architectural and Planning
1.8 Board, called the board or the CAAPB in this chapter, has ~~ten~~ 12 members.

1.9 (b) The lieutenant governor is a member.

1.10 (c) The governor must appoint four members.

1.11 (d) The mayor of St. Paul must appoint three members with the advice and consent
1.12 of the city council. One of the mayor's appointees must be a resident of the planning
1.13 council district that includes the Capitol Area.

1.14 (e) The speaker of the house must appoint a member of the house of representatives
1.15 and the president of the senate must appoint a senator. In addition, the members of the
1.16 house of representatives and of the senate whose legislative districts include the greatest
1.17 part of the capitol area serve ex officio as nonvoting members of the board. The nonvoting
1.18 members must not be counted for purposes of determining a quorum.

1.19 (f) Each appointee must qualify by taking the oath of office.

1.20 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.21 This act is effective the day following final enactment.
