1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **APPROPRIATIONS.**

1.7 \$..... is appropriated from the state government special revenue fund for fiscal years  
1.8 2008 and 2009 to the commissioner of health in fiscal year 2008 and in fiscal year 2009 to  
1.9 be used for statewide food, beverage, and lodging program development activities. For  
1.10 fiscal year 2010 and thereafter, this appropriation shall be from the general fund.

1.11 Sec. 2. **REPEALER.**

1.12 Minnesota Statutes 2006, sections 157.15, subdivision 19; and 157.16, subdivision  
1.13 3a, are repealed.
