The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; authorizing spending to acquire and better public
1.3 land and buildings and other improvements of a capital nature; authorizing
1.4 the issuance of state bonds; appropriating money for the city of St. Paul for a
1.5 youth drop-in center.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **ST. PAUL; YOUTH DROP-IN CENTER.**

1.8 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$586,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the
1.10 city of St. Paul to renovate a city-owned building for use by the St. Paul police as a
1.11 drop-in center with education and other programs for juveniles who have violated curfew.
1.12 The city may enter into an agreement with a nongovernmental entity that will lease the
1.13 building from the city and operate the program, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section
1.14 16A.695. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of finance determines
1.15 that at least an equal amount is committed to the project from nonstate sources.

1.16 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.17 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the state in
1.18 an amount up to \$586,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by
1.19 Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution,
1.20 article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
