APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in "David Lee and Pearl Lee v. State of Louisiana, DOTD"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
3 2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "David Lee and Pearl
4 Lee v. State of Louisiana, DOTD"; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. The sum of Twenty-One Thousand Five Hundred and No/100
7 (\$21,500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana
8 for Fiscal Year 2008-2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "David
9 Lee and Pearl Lee v. State of Louisiana, DOTD", bearing Number 57244 on the docket of
10 the Eleventh Judicial District Court, parish of Sabine, state of Louisiana.

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008; if vetoed by the governor
12 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
13 2008, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
