**Abstract:** Requires that notice of the prohibition of possessing a firearm in any alcoholic beverage outlet be posted on a sign at or near the entrance.

Present law (R.S. 14:95.5) provides that it is unlawful to enter an alcoholic beverage outlet while intentionally possessing a firearm.

Present law (R.S. 14:95.4(E)) provides that a sign be posted outside of alcohol beverage outlets advising patrons that they are subject to search for firearms upon entering the premises.

Proposed law adds to the notice requirement in present law by requiring that a sign be posted outside of every alcoholic beverage outlet to advise patrons that it is unlawful to enter the premises while intentionally possessing a firearm.
