APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Provides for supplemental capital outlay appropriations for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 to provide for the construction of I-49 North (Item #8)

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2007-
3 2008 to provide for construction costs related to Interstate 49 North; to provide for
4 an effective date; and to provide for related matters

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
7 the state of Louisiana for the purpose of making supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year
8 2007-2008, such monies to be comprised wholly of nonrecurring revenues out of the state
9 general fund for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 as recognized by the Revenue Estimating
10 Conference. Appropriations contained herein shall supplement, and shall be incorporated
11 into, the comprehensive state capital budget for Fiscal Year 2007-2008.

16 Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)

20 Provided, however, that the provisions of Sections 2 through 18, inclusive, of Act 28 of the
21 2007 Regular Session of the Legislature are adopted and incorporated by reference for
22 purposes of this appropriation.

23 Section 2. This Act is hereby deemed to be and shall be known as the I-49 North

24 Now Act.

1 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5 effective on the day following such approval.
