A RESOLUTION

To express the condolences and heartfelt sorrow of the House of Representatives upon the death of Willie C. Glover III of Shreveport.

WHEREAS, it is with sincere regret and profound sorrow that the members of the Louisiana House of Representatives have learned of the untimely departure of Willie C. Glover III; and

WHEREAS, with the tragic death of Willie C. Glover III during the early morning hours of Saturday, March 8, 2008, Louisiana has lost one of its finest citizens and brightest minds; and

WHEREAS, Willie C. Glover III was a son of Shreveport, born there on December 29, 1982, to Willie C. Glover Jr. and Dorothy D. Glover, attended Fair Park High School, where he was a honor roll student and graduated in the top ten percent of the class of 2000, and soon enlisted in the United States Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, Willie C. Glover III chose to further his education at Southern University, where his infectious personality caused him to quickly gain the admiration of his peers; and

WHEREAS, Willie C. Glover III decided to pursue a career in criminal justice and at the time of his death had only nine hours of matriculation remaining before receiving a bachelor's degree; and

WHEREAS, Willie C. Glover III was an active and loyal member of the Alpha Sigma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., where he exemplified the true meaning of brotherhood and honored his pledge to help others in school, his fraternity, and his community; and

WHEREAS, holding true to his favorite quote, "Life is not measured by the breaths we take, but by the moments that take our breath away", Willie loved life and made sure that those in his presence did the same; and

WHEREAS, he cherished time spent with family and friends and was always the center of attention, and he was a friend in all senses of the word; and

WHEREAS, the memory of Willie C. Glover III shall live long in the hearts and minds of all those whose lives he touched with his sincere handshake or infectious smile.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express its sincere sorrow at the loss of Willie C. Glover III.
