CAMPAIGN FINANCE EG SEE FISC NOTE GF EX Page 1 of 1  
 Prohibits the appointment or nomination of certain campaign contributors. (gov sig)

Provides that any person who makes a \$2,500 or more contribution to a candidate cannot be nominated or appointed by such candidate to any agency. Prohibits the spouse, immediate family member and business or corporation, other than a publicly traded corporation of such contributor from being nominated or appointed. Effective upon governor's signature.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This legislation would require the staff of the Ethics Administration Program to make changes to information sheets produced and distributed by the Ethics Administration Program on the provisions of the Ethics Code. However, these are costs that can be absorbed in the current budget and would not require additional funding. It is unknown how many complaints would be filed with the Ethics Board because of the proposed legislation. If substantially more complaints are filed additional staff (attorney, investigator and clerical) and resources may be required.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The board may impose a fine for violating the provisions provided for in this bill. The board cannot predict the amount of fines that may be imposed. All fees and fines are deposited in the general fund.
