ADMINISTRATION DIVISION. Provides for the Louisiana Electronic Catalog. (8/15/08)

1 AN ACT
2 To enact R.S. 39:1561(C), relative to the commissioner of administration; to provide for the
3 creation and maintenance of the "Louisiana Electronic Catalog"; to provide for its
4 contents; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6 Section 1. R.S. 39:1561(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7 §1561. Authority and duties of the commissioner of administration
8 * * *
9 **C. The commissioner shall establish and provide for an Internet-based**
10 **shopping tool for placement of contract orders by state agencies and political**
11 **subdivisions to facilitate placing orders for supplies, services, and repairs**
12 **online, and provide that all information on each contract in the system is**
13 **archived for three years following the expiration of the contract.**
14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on August 15, 2008.

DIGEST

Proposed law provides that the commissioner of administration establish and provide for an Internet-based shopping tool for placement of contract orders by state agencies and political subdivisions to facilitate placing orders for supplies, services, and repairs online, and provide that all information on each contract in the system is archived for three years following the expiration of the contract.

Effective on August 15, 2008.
