Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION: Provides with respect to qualifications for motor vehicle registration

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:515(4), relative to qualifications for vehicle registration; to provide relative
3 to registration of vehicles with unpaid parking violations; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 47:515(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §515. When registration shall be refused

8 The commissioner shall not grant an application for the registration of a
9 vehicle in any of the following events:

10 * * *

11 (4) When the vehicle has unpaid parking violations recorded against it.

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16 effective on the day following such approval.

HB No. 346

Abstract: Provides that the office of motor vehicles shall not issue vehicle registration for vehicles that have unpaid parking violations recorded against them.

Present law provides for the registration of motor vehicles and provides that a vehicle shall not be registered if:

- (1) The applicant is not entitled to registration under present law.
- (2) The applicant has not provided required information.
- (3) The tax and fees have not been paid.

Proposed law retains present law and additionally provides that a vehicle with unpaid parking fines recorded against it shall not be registered.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
