AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 15:574.22(G)(2)(d), relative to eligibility for evaluation by the Louisiana Risk Review Panel; to provide with respect to the number of years a person convicted of a Schedule I narcotic violation must serve in actual custody to be eligible for review by the Louisiana Risk Review Panel; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 15:574.22(G)(2)(d) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§574.22. Louisiana Risk Review Panel

* * *

G. The panel shall have the duty to evaluate the risk of danger to society which each person who has been convicted of a crime not defined or enumerated as a crime of violence in R.S. 14:2(13), and who is confined in a prison facility of any kind, may present if released from confinement. However, the panel shall not evaluate the risk of danger to society presented by:

* * *

(2) A person convicted of a violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law except for any of the following:

(d) A person sentenced to a term of life imprisonment for a violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law who has served at least ~~twenty~~ seven years of the term of imprisonment in actual custody. However, the provisions of this
