APPROPRIATIONS: Payment of consent judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in the suit entitled "Harry A. LeBlanc v. W. J. Trappey, Sr."

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2005-
3 2006 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Harry A. LeBlanc
4 v. W. J. Trappey, Sr."; to provide for costs; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. The sum of Fifty Thousand and No/100 (\$50,000.00) Dollars, plus costs
7 in the amount of Five Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-seven and 42/100 (\$5,947.42) Dollars,
8 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year
9 2005-2006 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Harry A. LeBlanc v.
10 W. J. Trappey, Sr.", bearing Number 87600-A on the docket of the Sixteenth Judicial
11 District Court, parish of Iberia, state of Louisiana.

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2005; if vetoed by the governor
13 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
14 2005, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
