APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Payment of judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in "Donald Zuber, et al v. the State of Louisiana through its Department of Transportation and Development, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
3 2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Donald Zuber, et
4 al v. the State of Louisiana through its Department of Transportation and
5 Development (DOTD) and T.L. James & Co., Inc."; and to provide for related
6 matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Thirty-Two Thousand and No/100 (\$32,000.00) Dollars is
9 hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
10 2009 to be used to pay the amounts awarded in the consent judgment in the suit entitled
11 "Donald Zuber, et al v. the State of Louisiana through its Department of Transportation and
12 Development (DOTD) and T.L. James & Co., Inc.", bearing Number 97-0797 on the docket
13 of the Fourth Judicial District Court, parish of Ouachita, state of Louisiana.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008; if vetoed by the governor
15 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
16 2008, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
