DIGEST

Proposed law provides that when appointments made by the governor, under his constitutional authority, which serves at the pleasure of the governor or serves a term concurrent with that of the governor, is not reappointed as provided by law, such shall be deemed automatically removed from office on October 31, of the year the new governor's term of office begins.

Proposed law further provides that when appointments made by the governor for an appointed term fixed by law, expires and is not reappointed, as provided by law, such shall be deemed automatically removed from office at the end of the next legislative session.

Present law provides that public business be performed in an open and public manner.

Present law provides definitions for the terms "meeting," "public body" and "quorum."

Effective August 15, 2008.
