APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in "Sam Dudley Fisher and Edith L. Fisher v. State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
3 2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Sam Dudley Fisher
4 and Edith L. Fisher v. State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and
5 Development"; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00) Dollars
8 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year
9 2008-2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Sam Dudley Fisher
10 and Edith L. Fisher v. State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development",
11 bearing Number 480,786-B on the docket of the First Judicial District Court, parish of
12 Caddo, state of Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008; if vetoed by the governor
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
15 2008, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
