DIGEST

Present law allows for the resale or offering for resale via the Internet of an admission ticket, at any price, to an athletic contest, dance, theater, concert, circus, or other amusement, if the organizer of the event and the operator of the location where the event is occurring authorizes admission tickets to such event to be resold for more than the price printed on the face of the ticket.

Proposed law limits the resale amount of the admission ticket to a maximum of two times the face value plus any applicable processing and delivery charges, and any other costs associated contributions or other payments in excess of the printed price requested by or made to an institution of higher education or to the affiliated alumni organization or foundation.

Effective August 15, 2008.
